ABOUT THE CHRISTADELPHIANS

The Christadelphians are a worldwide community of believers in the revealed Word of God, and the Gospel of Jesus Christ as contained in the Holy Scriptures, the Bible. The term "Christadelphian" means simply "Brethren in Christ." Originally founded and organized as a small community, circa 1850, Christadelphians are found in over 50 countries today.

Our community has no paid ministers or clergy. The activities of the group (including all aspects of the Sunday Worship Service) are conducted on a rotating basis by the brethren of the Ecclesia (assembly of believers). You will notice that we refer to one another as "brother" or "sister," signifying our deep and abiding love for one another as members of God's family.

We believe that Jesus of Nazareth was a man having a mortal nature the same as our own; at the same time, he was and is the Son of the Eternal God. Jesus was the Lamb of God, without spot or blemish, and became the Saviour for all true believers through his unblemished life of obedience and his willing sacrifice on the cross.
